PICK YOUR FAVORITE AND MOST UNIQUE IDEA AND DRAW IT!

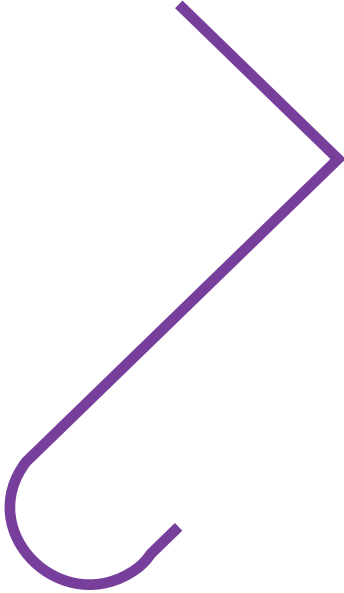
NOW TRY IT!
